## Outer Loop Meeting Set

Officials with the Texas Department of Transportation are inviting local residents to kick-off the New Braunfels outer loop study during an informal public meeting scheduled for 10 a.m. Wednesday at the Main Plaza bandstand in New Braunfels.

The purpose of the meeting is to officially announce the first round of public meetings as well as the unveiling of the New Braunfels outer loop study hotline and Web site, said TxDOT officials.

Preliminary plans for the loop include a 40-mile stretch of road that could intersect Interstate 35 at Kohlenberg and Conrad roads.

“The loop itself is just a theory. We don’t have anything specific,” TxDOT area designer Linda Grimsley said last week. “Right now we have a shaded area on a Comal County map.”
