New Braunfels loop input being sought

The Texas Department of Transportation will hold two public meetings this month to gather input for the New Braunfels Outer Loop Study.

The first will be 6-8:30 p.m. June 26 at Canyon High School at 1510 Interstate 35 East in New Braunfels. The second will be 6-8:30 p.m. June 27 at Hoffmann Lane Elementary School at 4600 FM 306 in New Braunfels.

The study will seek to identify a corridor for right-of-way preservation, and identify and prioritize segments of the loop. The study area is about a 40-mile band around the city and would require two new crossings over the Guadalupe River.
